



Use of Copyright

All faculty are responsible for securing copyright releases for all text, graphics, and photos taken from other sources and providing copies of these releases to AAPA.

A copyright release is a document written by a copyright holder allowing you to use their copyrighted work in a specified way. It is important that you tell the copyright holder that you would like to use their information in a continuing medical education (CME) presentation to the national conference of PAs and if you plan to include it as part of your electronic handout that will be posted online for conference registrants.
