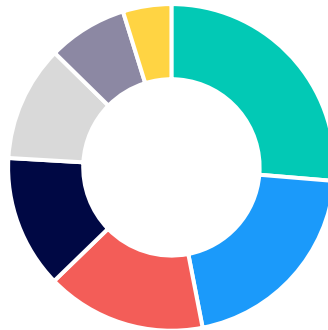

- 25.8% Surgical subspecialties
- 20.2% All other specialties
- 15.5% Internal medicine subspecialties
- 12.9% Family medicine
- 11.2% Emergency medicine
- 7.7% Urgent care
- 4.7% General peds, general IM

**Percent of PAs
by Setting
in Virginia**



- 43.8% Physician office or clinic
- 40.3% Hospital settings
- 9.4% Other settings
- 6.4% Urgent care center

In Virginia:

- ▶ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▶ A typical PA is on call 48 hours per month
- ▶ 74.3% of Virginia PAs would choose their career over again
