- 6.6% Urgent care

**Percent of PAs
by Setting
in North Carolina**



- 57.4% Physician office or clinic
- 30.1% Hospital settings
- 6.8% Other settings
- 5.7% Urgent care center

In North Carolina:

- ▶ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▶ A typical PA is on call 24 hours per month
- ▶ 61.1% of North Carolina PAs would choose their career over again
